through the streets of Marseilles. Interestingly, the race starts and finishes a structure called the Orange Velodrome but which is actually a soccer stadium. With stadium seating like a soccer stadium -- and all those seats will be filled. Two temporary roads were built into and out of the stadium just for this time trial. Although the course is short, it's extremely technical with lot of twists, turns, and tight corners. There's even a hairpin at the turn around.
