



Mons Soseman Coverage. Race Coverage. Minor race coverage. Minor O8-May-2018 Coverage of a Major race. Such is the challenge of the modern cycling fan. Ah the good old days. When Lance was king, media sources bloomed with information about the Tour de France, first, and then after a year or so, cycling in all its forms. The Canadians jumped in with OLN, and we achieved cycling Nirvana.

**Mons Soseman** Ah, the really good bad old days. When LeMond was king, 08-May-2018 we had a very occasional paragraph, on the bottom of the stats page of the newspaper Sports section. A paragraph would appear on a semi irregular basis, just to throw a bone to crazy cyclists and hippies, and only for the Tour de France. Because France. There was usually also one hour of television, once a week, on CBS, during the Tour, sometimes that was every Sunday afternoon of the Tour, so three times, sometimes just the one hour, per year, on the last day of the Tour. Following cycling, stateside, had never been easy.

Mons Soseman Although easier today in Europe, it is not always easy there, either. Sometimes a minor soccer game is considered more important than a stage, so although the network has broadcast stages of cycling Monday through Saturday, even showing replays of previous stages on the rest day, sometimes they don't show Sunday's stage live, or ever. Because soccer.

**Mons Soseman** Radio coverage of cycling is, unbelievably, even more rare. Europe regulates radio differently, so in the large cities and in some places throughout entire countries, there is no dead air on the entire FM band. Each frequency is covered with a broadcast, and the way it works, sometimes with two or three

stations bleeding over into each other. France also has a healthy and wonderful long wave radio market, under the guise of providing broadcasts for the ships at sea. Despite constant searches over many years, I only found cycling coverage on radio once or twice, once whilst in France, and that on long wave. Radio coverage is more rare today than it once was. When I was in college, when visiting Belgium, I would sometimes search for radio coverage of cycling, but more often found coverage of the pigeon races. Yes Pigeon races. Every. Sunday. Morning.

Mons Soseman So, for the last ten years, it was a luxury finding cycling coverage on European networks (except for the occasional Sunday, or course, during the Vuelta, when coverage of Serie B or C soccer or intermural water polo was suddenly more important). Some days I had a choice of three or even four networks, all broadcasting the same stage, and in a variety of available languages. Once I tuned into the Eurosport coverage of a classic in Belgium, and chose the Flemish language audio band. Fun. Well, it was fun for five minutes then I selected an alternate audio source. Even knowing I would come home stateside someday, I knew I would be able to get RAI and TVE on the Dish Network, and so I was so self satisfied, and "set."

Mons Soseman Until a few weeks ago, when I called Dish Network about 08-May-2018 some changes in programming. It had been the provider of choice here already, so I thought it would be easy. They told me all the equipment I had was archaic and would have to be replaced, so no RAI, no Giro, no hope. Alas. Yes, I have heard of Steep Hill, or other providers, but why would I want to watch blurry, two inch coverage of cycling for five hours on my laptop? I have heard about ways to fool the computer into thinking I was in Europe, but haven't had time to track that down. So, again, Alas, and Alack, and woe and fie.

Mons Soseman So, we are down to the dogs, or to the nuts, as the case may be. We are following cycling through Sicily, as we do every year, and sometime soon I will get around to more local color, but not today. I am comfortably following the Lugnuts, and doing what needs to be done, with no frantic search for yet another "stream." Enjoy the Giro. Enjoy the Day.
